Positions Available

Please apply for one of the following positions:

- **Policy Intern** The Policy Intern works primarily with the Deputy Director and Policy Analyst and typically writes a brief or report related to Tennessee state-policy and may help with other research projects, as needed. Duties include carrying out relevant research, analysis, and writing. Original research ideas consistent with Sycamore's mission and research agenda are welcome. Current or recent undergraduate and graduate students with an interest in state criminal justice, social, health, and/or fiscal policy issues and those with training in statistics and data analysis are encouraged to apply.
- Administration & Communications Intern The Administration & Communications Intern works primarily with the Communications and Engagement Manager. Duties may include assisting with operations, scheduling, public relations, and event planning. Current or recent undergraduate and graduate students with strong writing skills and an interest in nonprofit management and communications are encouraged to apply.

College credit is optional, and not required. We will provide appropriate documentation if necessary. Interns commit to spending a minimum of 10 hours a week in our downtown Nashville office.
